5 mistakes new wax melt users *make*

Save this before your next melt. Most folks get #2 wrong every time.

01

Burning the *whole bar* at once

One snap bar is *three sessions*. Break a single cube off, warm it for 4–6 hours, then save the rest. You get triple the scent and a fraction of the cost.



02

Putting it on a *hot warmer*

Drop the wax in cold. A pre-heated dish makes the wax shock and pop. Cold-load, plug in, walk away — you'll smell it inside ten minutes.

Pouring *used wax* down the drain

Wax + pipes = a \$300 plumber call. When the scent fades, let the wax cool, pop the disc out, and toss it. The dish wipes clean with a paper towel.

Mixing *too many scents*

Three scents in one warmer = nothing readable. Pick one bar per room, or pair two from the same family (citrus + citrus, floral + floral). Your nose will thank you.
